

UMP Hornets 2026

[In addition to general rules]

- Only 4 cylinder engines allowed. (No Rotary or Turbo Chargers) No Performance Parts Allowed
- OEM Shocks Only. (NO Racing shocks)
- NO Racing Rims or Wheels Allowed. (NO Bead locks)
- ONLY Street Legal DOT Tires Allowed. (Stagger Allowed)
- Stock OEM Frames, steering, rear ends, transmissions, wheels, brakes, etc for make and model
- Roll cage 1½ inch dia. tubing required. It must be at least 4 point mount floor to roof, X brace behind driver seat, two braces roof loop to truck floor, cross brace at dash, full roof loop, 3 bars in driver's door, and at least 2 in passenger door.
- No Mirrors of any kind
- Fire Extinguisher required
- **Fire Suit, Gloves, Helmet, 5 mount racing harness and Raceceiver Required**
- Battery must be covered in a box
- Doors are to be welded or chained shut
- Driver's seat may be replaced with a racing seat
- The stock gas tank must be in stock location. Recommended to use Fuel cell mounted securely in trunk
- Exhaust must exit behind driver
- Gas station fuel ONLY with NO additives. (Fuel must be clear)
- Window Net recommended
- All Glass, Plastic and Chrome must be removed from car
- All cars are to be neatly painted and have at least 16 inch high numbers on each side of the car and roof which can be read from main grandstands.
- Drivers 14 to 18 years of age may be allowed to compete with parental permission form signed/notarized and sign waiver at pit entry
- Driver's will also use same rules set forth in General rules
- Transponder and pouch to be mounted on rear torsion bar ONLY

Any rule covered or not covered will be interpreted by officials and management. Management of Spoon River Speedway reserves the right to change any rule or interpretation of any rules at any time in the interest of better competition or safety.
